FLB 402: REGIONAL INTEGRATION LAW

QUESTION 1

Jumuiya and Mashariki are membersstates of the East African Community. Recently Masharikiimposed 25% import duty and 90% excise duty on chewing gum and other confectionary products imported from Jumuiyaon the basis that manufacturers in Jumuiyause industrial sugar imported from outside the community to manufacture the products. Masharikialso instructed Masharaki Revenue Authority to reject allcertificates of origin issued by JumuiyaRevenue Authority (JRA) for confectionary products from Jumuiya. Mashariki argued that Jumuiya had enacted Sugar (Importation) Regulation of January 2022 that allowed for duty free importation of sugar from foreign markets by the manufacturers of confectionary products.

Jumuiya protested these measures and demanded that the products be granted duty free access to the <u>Mashariki</u> market in line with the spirit of economic liberalization within the community. Jumuiya further argued that no manufacturer has imported sugar for industrial use and that the Sugar (Importation) Regulation of January 2022 did not permit importation of industrial sugar. It permitted duty free importation of sugar for domestic use in order to stabilize prices of sugar for domestic use. Jumuiya has threatened to ban importation of maize and dairy products from Masharikiif the measures are not reversed with immediate effect.

Advise the two partner states on the legality of the proposed measures and the legal mechanisms available to them to resolve the dispute. The relevant part of Annex III of the of East African Community Customs Union (Rules of Origin) Rules 2015 is set out below:
